General Commands

- Command (⌘) + Space → Open Spotlight search
- Command (⌘) + Tab → Switch between open apps
- Command (⌘) + Q → Quit current app
- Command (⌘) + H → Hide current window
- Command (⌘) + M → Minimize window


Screenshots

- Shift + Command (⌘) + 3 → Full screen screenshot
- Shift + Command (⌘) + 4 → Select area screenshot
- Shift + Command (⌘) + 5 → Screenshot toolbar (capture/record screen)

Classroom Handy

- Control + Command (⌘) + Q → Lock screen quickly
- Command (⌘) + Option + D → Show/hide Dock
- Control + Up Arrow → Mission Control
- Control + Down Arrow → App Exposé

Browser / Teaching Tools

- Command (⌘) + T → New tab
- Command (⌘) + W →  Close tab
- Command (⌘) + Shift + T → Reopen closed tab
- Command (⌘) + L → Highlight URL bar
- Command (⌘) + Option + Esc → Force quit an app
